

We would like to offer our ongoing support towards achieving Scottish Government's mission of delivering a revolution in children's human rights.


This week, we will travel to Geneva for the UK's review by the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child. This will be an opportunity for the UN Committee to assess Scotland's progress since its last review in 2016 as well as new and emerging issues. Earlier this year, we gave evidence before the UN Committee on key issues that matter for children and young people across Scotland. One of the top issues was children and young people's frustration that the *UNCRC (Incorporation) (Scotland) Bill* is still not law despite having been passed unanimously by MSPs over two years ago. You can read the full report from children and young people here and from Together here.

We recognise that this is a time of change for Scottish Government. At the same time, challenges to ensuring children and young people's rights are respected, protected and fulfilled have become even more acute – particularly for children whose rights are already most at risk. It is more important than ever that children's human rights is put into law as soon as possible. We were pleased to receive <u>reassurance from the First Minister</u> that he remains committed to the UNCRC Incorporation Bill and to working with children and young people on next steps.

We know that the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child commends Scotland's commitment to incorporation and is likely to ask Scottish Government officials for an update on progress and expected timelines next week. The UN Committee will publish its full recommendations in early June covering a broad range of issues related to UNCRC incorporation and implementation. We are committed to working constructively with you to ensure these recommendations are fully implemented and that structures are put in place to ensure children and young people can hold Scottish Government and public authorities to account on progress.

Together's UNCRC Implementation Strategy Group, made up of around 44 organisations, would like to invite you to meet with them to discuss Scottish Government plans to take forward the UNCRC Incorporation (Scotland) Bill and the UN Committee's forthcoming recommendations. Please could you let us know your availability for such a meeting.
